Data transmission of Race Results

It is possible to send race results 4 different ways:

1. Internet E-Mail using address AlpineResults@fisski.ch
AlpineResults@fisski.org

Note: Attach files to the mail. Do not compress

Note: Send Results to both addresses above.

2. Use last years version of Send-Race and dial 41-33-243 09 90
3. Use internet ftp protocol at the address <ftp.fisski.org/alpine/results>
4. Use normal mail, Courier, or the special Fax Number

Files containing race results must follow the naming convention using the codex format NAT####.### File cannot be compressed.

Note: The only file format which will guarantee immediate inclusion in the FIS List is "ski dataFormat 2.02", the old matrix format will not be supported. Results in the old format can be sent but will not be loaded automatically and therefore may not be included in the next FIS List, particularly at or near the end of a list period.

Faxed or mailed results, even if sent on time may not make the list.

Organizers are urged to check and ensure that their race software produces results in "Ski Data 2.02"

There will be no receipt or acknowledgement from FIS when results are sent

The FIS official database will be www.fis.ch

The FIS points list will be available at <ftp.fisski.org/alpine/lists9899/> and is capable of formatted down loading with a new Fislist program which has been provided to USSA, Alpine Canada and to Canada's point list Manager

Race organisers are encouraged to use these sites and to transmit results via the Internet. Contact Alpine Canada or US Ski and Snow Board Association for information on the "ski data format".
