



2024-2025 International FIS Athlete Service Fee

June 25, 2024

WHO:

Applies to Canadian FIS licensed athletes who are participating in an international program **outside of** Canada and electing to start in FIS competitions.

Examples of programs that Canadian athletes participate in outside of Canada include (but are not limited to):

- USA Academies (Burke Mtn, GMVS, Sugar Bowl, etc.),
- USA Universities/Colleges (Montana State, UVM, Plymouth, University of Utah, etc.)
- USA Clubs (Steamboat Springs, Vail, Palisades / Tahoe etc.)
- International club or academy programs (ISRA, LIT, Orsatus, Apex2100, Alta Badia, etc.)

AND

Applies to Canadian FIS Licensed Masters athletes who are participating in an international FIS race **outside of** Canada

FEE: \$150

To provide the service required to support the entry process for these Canadian athletes who compete outside of Canada, an annual fee of \$150.00 CAD is now applicable.

WHY:

To appropriately service CAN FIS licensed athletes participating in programs and/or Masters races outside of Canada, additional time and resources are required to ensure that their program(s) can be supported in the manner to which is expected.

Insurance and Registration

- **Additional membership requirements:** Increased time commitment to external programs / athletes/guardians to understand the specific requirements with increased administrative management of athletes in varied situations. Examples include unique waiver/exclusion documents and insurance coordination to ensure that minimum FIS and ACA standards are met for licensing and membership.

FIS Race Entry Administration

- **NSO Mandate:** ACA is responsible for the entry of ALL CAN FIS licensed athletes competing in international FIS competitions. No entry can be submitted without following ACA's procedures for entry and acceptance.
- **Coach Management:** Education and resource dedication to support programs and their coaches to ensure they are knowledgeable and integrated into the Canadian system and understanding processes/requirements.
- **ROC Communication:** Ongoing and timely communication on race entries, changes, and waitlist management with a sensitivity to global time zone requirement. Communication between, NSO, ROC, coach and/or athlete(s) pending program structure or urgency.
- **Quota:** CAN is restricted on quota for international FIS competitions, with an increased number of athletes participating in international programs, there are increased management requirements of quota allocation, waitlist management and communication required.
